7. FINANCIAL EVALUATION

- a) Margin of Preference will be applied to bidders who have attached the Local sourcing declaration in its bid, outlining the preferences the bidder qualifies for and the grounds for such qualifications in terms of Section 9 (3) of the Code of good practice on preferences.
- b) Bids below 10% or above 10% of the cost estimate will be deemed to be non-responsive.
- c) Bidders will be ranked according to price quoted or offers (from lowest to highest). The contract shall be awarded to the lowest evaluated substantially responsive bid in terms of Section 55 (1) of the Public Procurement Act, 2015 (Act No. 15 of 2015).
