SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Rights of Public Entity

The Directorate of Education, Innovation, Youth, Sports, Arts and Culture reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per item, or
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation; and
- (c) to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the items mentioned in Section III by completing, signing, and returning:

- (a) the Quotation Letter in Section II with its annexure for Bid Securing Declaration
- (b) the List of Goods and Price Schedule Section III;
- (c) any other attachment deemed appropriate.

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Sealed Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your quotation. The standard forms in this document may be re-typed for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Quotations

The Quotation validity period shall be **30 days** from the date of submission deadline.

1. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

- (a) Have a valid Certified Company Registration Certificate.
 - (b) Have a valid original/Certified copy of good Standing Tax Certificate.
 - (c) Have a valid original/Certified copy of Good Standing Social Security Certificate;
 - (d) Have a valid Certified copy of Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998;
 - (e) Submit signed Bid-securing Declaration.
 - (f) No Tippex (Correction fluid) should be used
 - (g) All corrections should be initialled
 - (h) Attach Certified Namibian Document (ID)
 - (i) **Compliance to the Public Procurement Act, 2015 (Act 15 of 2015) as amended.**
- Section 66 (2B) (a) states that "staff members of the public entity; may not participate either personally or through an entity corporate or incorporate in which he or she has a financial, economic or personal interest, as a bidder or supplier in a procurement process conducted by the Board or public entity;

4. Bid Securing Declaration

Bidders are required to subscribe to a Bid Securing Declaration for this procurement process.

5. Delivery

Delivery shall be thirty **(30) days** after acceptance/issue of Purchase Order. Deviation in delivery period shall be considered if such deviation is reasonable.

6. Sealing and Marking of Quotations

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the Public Entity with the Bidder's name and contact information at the back of the envelope.

7. Submission of Quotations

Quotations should be submitted to the Kavango West Regional Council not later than **22 July 2025 at 10h00**. Quotations by post or hand delivered should reach the Secretariat, Procurement Management Unit, Kavango West Regional Council, Nkurenkuru Plaza, Nkurenkuru, by the same date and time at latest. Late quotations will be rejected. Quotations received by e-mail will not be considered.

8. Opening of Quotations

Quotations will be opened internally by the Public Entity immediately after the closing time referred to in instruction 8 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted and the presence or absence of a Bid Securing Declaration.

9. Evaluation of Quotations

The Public Entity shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of price or ownership cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

10. Technical Compliance

Bidders shall submit along with their quotation's documents, catalogues and any other literature to substantiate compliance with the required specifications and to qualify deviations if any with respect to Public Entity's requirements.

The Specifications, Performance Requirements and Compliance Sheet details the minimum specifications of the goods/items to be supplied. The specifications have to be met but no credit will be given for exceeding the specifications.

11. Prices and Currency of Payment

Public Entity may **not** allow for prices to be adjustable to change in rates of exchange of currency, price variation etc.

Prices shall be fixed in Namibian Dollars.

12. Margin of Preference

12.1. The applicable margins of preference and their application methodology are not applicable

13. Award of Contract

The Bidder having submitted the lowest evaluated responsive quotation and qualified to supply the goods/items and related services shall be selected for award of contract. Award of contract shall be by issue of a Purchase Order/Letter of Acceptance in accordance with terms and conditions contained in Section VI: Contract Agreement and General Conditions of Contract.

14. Notification of Award and Debriefing

The Public Entity shall after award of contract promptly inform all unsuccessful bidders in writing of the name and address of the successful bidder and the contract amount. Furthermore, the Public Entity shall attend to all requests for debriefing made in writing within seven (7) days of the unsuccessful bidders being informed of the award.
